JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title and Summary: Behaviour and Enrichment Assistant. The candidate will assist in providing behavioural support for the dogs and cats at the shelter, as well as taking part in the implementation and continuation of enrichment programs for the shelter animals.

Key Responsibilities:

- Take part in the preparation, implementation and continuation of behavioural and enrichment programs for the animals at the shelter
- Learn and apply principles of animal behaviour modification
- Assist with behavioural rehabilitation
- Make accurate observations and record information in written reports
- Carry out behavioural assessments of shelter dogs

Department and Supervisor: The candidate will be part of the Soi Dog animal welfare department, working under the behaviour and enrichment manager, with supervision of the behaviour and enrichment team leader. The candidate will be working as part of a team. Tasks will involve working together with members of their own team, and will extend to working with staff in other departments, and volunteers.

Skills and Qualifications: The candidate should be able to understand and communicate in Thai and English, and be able to work with a diverse staff. They must have a passion for animals, and a desire to work with dogs and cats, involving regular interaction with them. They are able to work towards specific goals in a systematic way, both independently and as part of a team. They should be driven to improve the welfare of the animals at the shelter. Experience with animals is desirable. Qualifications relating to requirements of the role (for example animal welfare, biology, psychology, English) are beneficial.

Location: The position is located at the Soi Dog Foundation shelter in Mai Khao, Phuket. It may involve occasional trips off-site if necessary.

Type of Employment: Full time paid position.

Benefits:

- Five-day work a week, 40 hours per week with two days off. Employee may start and finish work different times depending on their duties as directed by their manager.
