### JOB DESCRIPTION

Join our dynamic team at Soi Dog Foundation, where you will work in a collaborative environment to create systems that enhance efficiency and support the progress of our foundation. As a Front-End Developer, you will play a crucial role in developing and maintaining our digital platforms, ensuring they are user-friendly, responsive, and effective in achieving our mission.

### Key Responsibilities

- Collaborate with UX/UI designers, backend developers, and stakeholders to implement front-end features and user interfaces.
- Write clean, scalable, maintainable, and efficient code using JavaScript, HTML, and CSS.
- Ensure cross-browser compatibility and optimize for both desktop and mobile platforms.
- Implement responsive design principles to ensure a seamless user experience across various screen sizes.
- Conduct thorough testing, including unit and integration testing, and debugging to ensure functionality and performance.
- Participate in code reviews and provide constructive feedback to maintain code quality and best practices.
- Contribute to continuous improvement by staying updated with emerging trends and technologies.
- Work closely with stakeholders to understand requirements and contribute to project planning, estimation, and timely delivery.
- Create technical documentation for reference and reporting.

### Skills and Qualification

- Proven experience as a Front-End Developer or similar role.
- Proficiency in JavaScript, HTML, and CSS.
- Experience with backend programming languages such as PHP or Python (desirable)

- Experience with modern front-end frameworks/libraries such as Vue, React, and/or Angular.
- Strong understanding of responsive design techniques and cross-browser compatibility testing.
- Experience with version control systems such as Git and/or Bitbucket.
- Familiarity with CI/CD pipelines and automated testing.
- Experience with Agile development methodologies.
- Strong problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- Excellent communication and collaboration abilities.
- Ability to work effectively in a fast-paced environment and manage multiple priorities.
- Understanding of web performance optimization techniques (e.g., lazy loading, bundling).

**Desired Experience:**

- Ability to develop cross-platform applications and leverage frameworks that deploy web UIs on both web and smartphones (e.g., React Native, Flutter, or similar technologies).
- Familiarity with native app development (iOS/Android) is a plus.

**Location:** This role is office-based, requiring the candidate to work from either the Phuket or Bangkok office.

For the Bangkok-based role. Initially, there will be a hybrid working arrangement with some work-from-home flexibility and as we establish our new office in Bangkok, this will transition to a full-time office-based position and can travel to Phuket when necessary. Soi Dog will cover flight and accommodation during working in Phuket.
