This position will lead on establishing new giving structures including a Development Board Programme, while also promoting legacy giving opportunities to ensure long-term sustainable income for Soi Dog Foundation.

Strategic Development & Implementation

- Lead the development and implementation of international high-value giving strategies including grants, major donors, and corporate partnerships
- Working closely with the Director of International Fundraising and marketing, launch the Development Board
 Programme strategy to engage high-net-worth supporters
- Develop and implement a donor journey programme, supporting the major giving senior officerto implement the plan
- Work closely with the Director of International Fundraising to set and achieve income targets
- Contribute to the overall fundraising strategy and annual planning process
